DYING FEATHERS

When dying feathers use the following instructions:-

Bring water to the boil then add one large teaspoonful of powdered Alum, put feathers in and make sure they are all soaked, put back on stove and bring slowly to the boil. When they have enough colour, strain through a fine gauze cloth or old silk stocking. Shake them on to a newspaper, spread before a slow fire and never squeeze.

The quantities for Dying can be measured by - keep to as near the amount shown by dot like these and always use a white enamel pot and always the same quantity of water - 2 pints.

Those flies are enough for April and the Quills for Large Olive and Greenwell are the two outermost feathers in Black Heated Gull Wings. The other dyed Quills for March Brown and Dark Olives are the outermost feathers in White Turkey Wings. Dye the Gull with daffodil only the Turkey Quills with Shearney Dye.

When the March Brown is tailing off, another good fly to fish then is a :
